Total estimate for first year is adjusted for ARF estimated adoption fee of \$265 including microchipping. Food estimates also adjusted for current inflation at \$1.50 per day assuming mix of quality wet & dry food fed daily based on what ARF cats are used to being fed.

Please note these estimates don't include veterinary sick care for cats. It only includes annual wellness exams. Emergency or sick care would be in addition to these figures and could be hundreds or thousands of dollars if the cat becomes unexpectedly ill and needs to see a vet or needs emergency veterinary care.
